Purpose of Position

Provide a learning opportunity for the intern in the high school ministry. Intern will assist with all aspects of the high school ministry (grades 9-12) and participate occasionally with the middle school ministry (grades 6-8).

Mission

The mission of Chapel Hill is to work together to present everyone mature in Christ. The mission of Student Ministries at Chapel Hill is to connect every student to Christ and His Community for a lifetime.

Primary Duties

1. Build relationships with students in order to present the gospel of Jesus Christ to them and encourage their growth through the study of scripture, prayer, fellowship and service.
2. Assist the High School Director with the planning and execution of ministry programs, including keeping students and parents informed regarding upcoming events.
3. Assist in the coordination and development of volunteers (students and adults).
4. Provide administrative support to the department, including publications, mailings, calendars, phone calls, etc.
5. Work amicably in conjunction with other Student Ministries staff and the greater church staff by performing other duties as assigned.

Knowledge and Experience

1. Growing personal commitment to Jesus Christ, the body of Christ and God's work in the world.
2. Ability to work effectively with youth, exhibiting creativity, understanding and patience.
3. Excellent communication skills (verbal and written)
4. Flexibility in a multi-task, fast-paced changing environment.

Internship Details

Benefits to Intern:

1. Gain practical ministry training and church experience
2. Work in an atmosphere of personal and professional guidance and support
3. Test their gifts and call to vocational ministry
4. Develop spiritually and theologically

Other Details:

1. Education: this internship is designed for post-college applicants whose studies have focused on ministry. Prior ministry work experience may be substituted for college studies.
2. Duration of internship: Approximately two years (beginning June 2012 through June 2012)
3. Compensation: \$18,800 per year
4. Housing: Room and board with a host family from Chapel Hill provided upon request.
5. Benefits: health, vacation (3 weeks per year), sick leave, holiday pay. Health coverage begins the first of the month following 30 days of employment. Other benefits accrue from date of hire.
