Primary Duties

- Prepare creative and engaging orders of worship in line with the vision and strategy of the Chapel Hill Church family, including collaboration with the Gig Harbor worship leads.
- Lead the musical portion of the Worship services in an energetic manner with sensitivity to the Holy Spirit.
- Select songs for the Worship services in a way that enables the congregation to sing and engage in worship, introducing new songs on a regular basis, retiring older songs when appropriate, and maintaining a repertoire of current songs.
- Create an engaging environment for the congregation by utilizing technology (music, lights, visuals etc.) to its full potential.
- Develop a process to regularly identify and deploy volunteers in the Worship music and tech teams.
- Shepherd, train, manage, and care for volunteers in the Worship music and tech teams.
- Other duties as assigned.
